Use TinkerCAD to design your town in 3D.



You can use any Minecraft but you have access to Minecraft Education through school.

Download and sign in using your c2ken username and password.

Design a town or world to tie in with your work.

Take screen shots to add to your project.



Make a 3D town in a virtual environment with CoSpaces.

Either download the app or go online.

The code is DRLWP

Use the above code, add your name, a username (I will recognise!) and create a password.

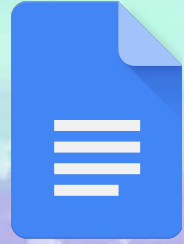
Save the details somewhere safe.

Use whatever Apps or programmes you have to write about your town.

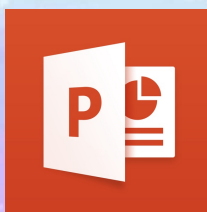
Things like descriptions of houses, streets, people who live there, etc.
